## INSIGHT FROM THE GOD'S WORD:

## EPIPHANY – It's Time To Take A Look!



As we look at the church calendar, we see that January 6<sup>th</sup> marks the beginning of the season of Epiphany. The season of Epiphany is a time when we take a cue from the wise men and take a look at what God is revealing to us in the sky above, in the words of ancient Scripture, in the Baby Jesus, and in the recesses of our very heart and soul.

### Look-Up

It was the wise men from the East who looked up and saw the star that told them that a King had been born. And the wise men kept looking up as they followed the star that led them to Jesus. It's time this Epiphany season to look up at the stars at night, marvel at God's creation, and commit your way to the Lord above, who has sent Jesus to be with us.

### Look Back

When the wise men got to Jerusalem, they asked King Herod, **"Where is the child who has been born king of the Jews?"** (Matthew 2:2). Herod called the chief priests and scribes to look back in Scripture. They found the answer in the words of the prophet Micah: **"You, O Bethlehem of Ephrathah, who are one of the little clans of Judah, from you shall come a ruler who is to shepherd my people Israel"** (Micah 5:2). It's time this Epiphany to look back at the words of Scripture that declare to us that Jesus is indeed the Messiah, the fulfillment of all the prophecies of old, the revelation of all the promises of God.

### Look Down

When the wise men found the Baby Jesus, they looked down, as they knelt before the Son of God and worshiped him. Only then did the wise men open their treasures of gold, frankincense, and myrrh to the Lord. It's time this Epiphany season to bow your heads in prayer to the Savior, to come to church for worship, and to humbly offer your gifts to the One who has given us so much - forgiveness, renewal, peace, hope, and love.

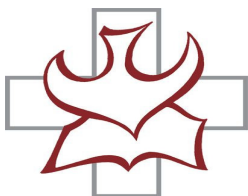
### **VOTERS MEETING (11/24/1019) SUMMARY**

The Mission and Stewardship Board has embraced an opportunity to assist some students in the OABCIG Community School District. We have been made aware of nutritional needs of some of the youth in our school district as well as a need for coats and other clothing items particularly for the winter months. The teachers at the school have a backpack program in which they send food items home in the student's backpack not just for the weekend but each night as well. We have asked the teachers directly involved in this task to let us know what food items are best to be a part of the backpack program. In the near future we will be providing a list of food items to our congregation members, this list will give us the best ideas as to what can be sent home with the students in their backpacks for their evening and weekend meals. We are going to have a tote available in the Narthex in which members who wish to contribute could place the items of food for the students. Our goal is to reach out and show Christ's love to our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ. In the meantime, we are using some of the money budgeted in the Special Missions Program to purchase new and gently used coats, clothing and shoes to help fill that need as well. This need is in every building of the OABCIG School District, currently we are working with a few teachers of the high school but we would like to make it our goal to help in a similar fashion in the middle school and elementary. If any member has any ideas or donations that they would like to make please let either Deb Clausen or Darcy Sibenaller know. In the meantime, be looking for the tote in the Narthex that will contain the list of the food items and please contribute if you are stirred to help in this way. Are you aware that we have students in our school district in need of meals not only on the weekends but each night as well? We would like to help the school in providing these much needed items to the students. Please take note of the tote in the narthex where you can donate backpack food items as well as hats, gloves and scarves for our OABCIG students. **Suggested backpack food items are single serving applesauces, pudding and jello cups, fruit cups, Easy Mac macaroni and cheese single serving cups, Dinty Moore single serving meals, granola bars, Nutri Grain bars, peanut butter crackers, etc. Only non-perishable food items please.**

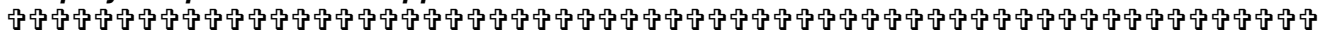
