Our mission is to grow in our faith in Jesus Christ in order to share that faith with others.

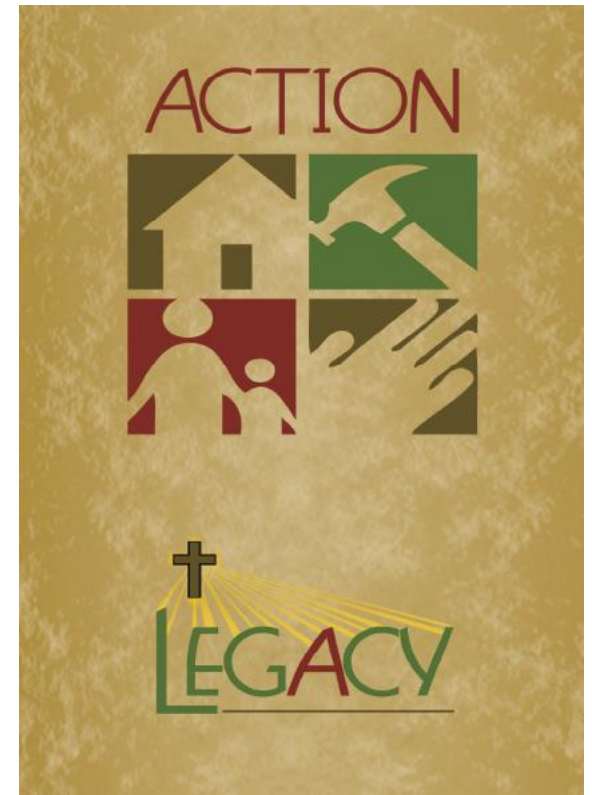
Our Vision
