

The education ministry which is probably most familiar is our Sunday School for children age 4 through grade 8. Sunday School is in session on Sunday mornings, 9:15 -10:15 AM, September through May.


Also for children we conduct a Mid-Week School for children in Grades 3 through 8 on Wednesdays, 4:15 - 5:15 PM on days when the public school is in session. This includes Confirmation instruction for 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders conducted by our pastors.

High School youth are also given an opportunity to grow in their faith in the Youth Bible Class in session year-round at 9:15 AM on Sunday mornings. This class is convened in the Youth Room in the lower level of the education building. Other opportunities are offered in special events. retreats. and gatherings.

Adults also have many and varied opportunities to grow in their faith.

- The Adult Bible Class is open to everyone who wants to grow in spiritual well being. Please join us in the Fellowship Hall for a cup of coffee while we read and discuss the Word of God and how He is here for us yesterday, today, and tomorrow.
- Get up early and join us for Bible \_ Study and a cup of coffee or maybe even breakfast at 6:30 AM at the Family Table Restaurant. Start Wednesdays off right with the nourishing Word of God.

- Wednesday mornings at 9:30 AM in the Conference Room study the Bible with a group of friends. Grow in your understanding of God's Word and share in fellowship and discussion.
- Wednesday On mornings (September – May), at 10:00 AM, ladies of all ages are invited to gather together. Renew and refresh yourself in the study of what God's Word has to say to us. Please come and bring a friend. Childcare is provided.





Missouri Synod we believe that education should address the whole person -- body, mind and spirit -- beginning in early childhood and

through higher education. Through early childhood programs, elementary schools, and high schools, the congregations of the LCMS are dedicated to providing a solid Lutheran Christian education for our children by operating the largest Protestant parochial school system in America. Schools are located throughout the United States. The closest Lutheran elementary School to Ida Grove is Zion Lutheran School in Dennison.

The LC-MS also operates 10 colleges and universities across the

United States through the Concordia University System. These universities offer more than 160 undergraduate and 50 graduate programs. While each institution is unique, all ten campuses approach learning from a Lutheran context. The common goal is to develop Christian leaders for the church, community and world. Scholarships available are to members, attending one of these colleges or universities for the purpose of entering full-time church work.

God has blessed the LC-MS with two excellent seminaries. One is located in St. Louis, Mo.; the other in Ft. Wayne, Ind. Through а combination of residential and distance education programs, both seminaries form pastors and deaconesses for service in the LCMS.

As the mission field expanded beyond the United States, the LC-MS opened schools throughout Asia in keeping with its strong focus on education. Today, the LC-MS operates three international schools.

Our mission is to grow in our faith in Jesus Christ in order to share that faith with others.


## **Our Vision**
